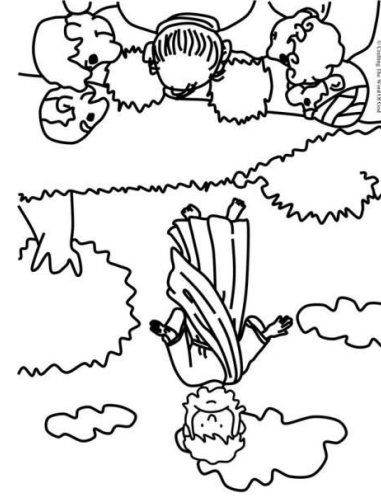


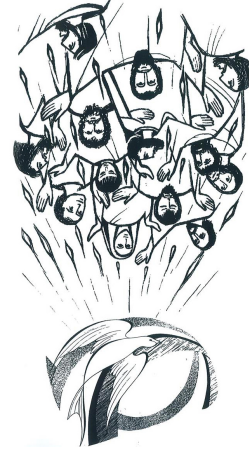
After rising from the dead, Jesus appeared to his disciples in lots of different places over 40 days.



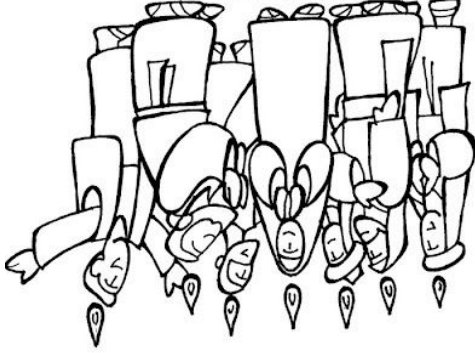
Then Jesus went up (ascended) to Heaven – this is what we call 'Ascension Day' in the Church.



Shortly afterwards the 'Day of Pentecost' happened. The disciples were all together in one place and there was a noise like a violent wind.



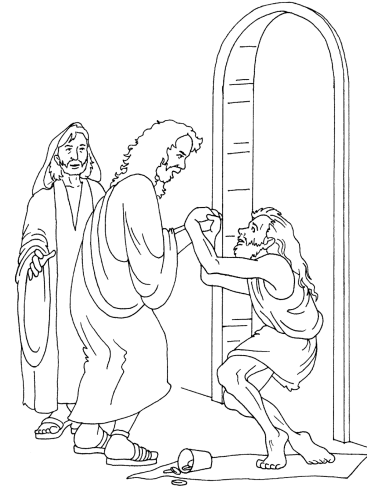
Tongues of fire rested on each of their heads, which was a sign that the Holy Spirit was with them, and they began to speak in languages they didn't know.
